Clinton, NC (September 7, 2011) – NASA may have completed their final Space Shuttle Mission, but a Shuttle will launch once again and this time from a corn field in Sampson County, North Carolina. Come out and enjoy Hubb's Corn Maze 2011 season. The Shuttle Mission will be from September 17, 2011 through November 6, 2011. Hubb's Corn Maze is an exciting outdoor alternative for fall activities, get togethers and celebrations. The season will open Saturday, September 17, 2011.

The theme of the Hubb's Corn Maze for 2011 is "Tribute to NASA's 30 –Year Space Shuttle Program. The maze is a series of three interactive mazes with maps, check points, and five miles of trails to create an adventure for all ages.

Hubb's Corn Maze offers plenty of activities for everyone to enjoy. After finding all the checkpoints in the maze, you may zoom down the 40 foot giant slide and then bounce to the skies on the Hubb's Giant Pop Jumping Pillow. Little ones can enjoy Toddler Town and a portion of the corn maze set aside just for them. Everyone can enjoy a quiet hay ride and a ride on the Hubb's Express Train. Lots of other activities are available for hours of fun. Finish your visit by purchasing just the right pumpkin for your fall decorations.

Agritourism is a face of agriculture that has gained popularity across the nation. Hubb's Corn Maze contracts with a maze designer from Idaho to cut their 12+ acre maze each year. The 5-foot –wide trails are cut into the field of corn using a GPS mapping system. The design makes for a spectacular aerial view as well as a challenging puzzle for the visitors.

"We want people to come out to our location and create memories and traditions that will last a life time. Not only does the detail of the maze design excite our fans, the other activities that are available provide hours of fun. The maze can be done during the day or at night. We also have a Haunted Corn Trail that is available weekends in October. The Haunted Corn Trail is separate from the Shuttle Themed Maze, which is not haunted," says Tammy Peterson, co-owner of Hubb's Corn Maze with her husband John.

Hubb's Corn Maze is located between Clinton and Dunn on Highway 421 North. The maze will be open to the public from September 17 through November 6 on Fridays 6 p.m. – 11 p.m., Saturdays 1 p.m. – 11 p.m., and Sundays 1 p.m. – 6p.m. Visit their website at www.hubbscornmaze.com for a complete listing of dates and events.
